On June 27, 2005, the Idaho Supreme Court issued an *Order Granting Motion for Remand* in consolidated subcase 03-10022 (Nez Perce Instream Flow Claims). The consolidated subcase was remanded for purposes of having this Court rule on the issues raised before the Supreme Court by the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and for conducting further proceedings on the negotiated agreement reached with respect to the all of the claims filed by the Nez Perce Tribe. On June 29, 2005, the participating parties to the settlement negotiations filed through counsel a *Joint Motion for Approval of Consent Decree, Entry of Final Partial Decrees, and Entry of Scheduling Order*.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that a status and scheduling conference is set for **Tuesday, July 19, 2005, at 1:30 p.m. (MDT), at the Canyon County Courthouse, District Courtroom #5, 3rd Floor, 1115 Albany, Caldwell, Idaho.
