On May 11, 2000, the United States of America, through its attorney of record R. Lee Leininger filed a *Notice of Challenge* to the Special Master's ***Order on the Motion of the United States to Alter or Amend the Special Master's Recommendation.***

On August 3, 2000, the *State of Idaho's Motion to Strike Affidavits* was filed in the above subcases, requesting that the *Affidavit of Karl A. Gebhardt* and the *Affidavit of Gary A. Madenford* be stricken as untimely and irrelevant.

The *Motion* was set to be heard on September 6, 2000, in conjunction with the oral arguments on challenge, but both were subsequently vacated by order of this Court. (September 1, 2000).
